
## Idaho All-State Auditions Flute

#4 in the materials listed below is an EXAMPLE of the optional solo each student can play. Solos are optional and will be used for consideration for principal positions only. The solo should be a piece of the student's choosing not to exceed 1 minute in length. The chosen piece should be relatively difficult for the student but should demonstrate the student's musical strengths. Pieces from each instrument's solo repertoire are recommended. Remember, the piece given here is an *example* only. It *may* be used, but a piece of the student's choosing is highly recommended.

1. Chromatic Scale – Low C to C7 using slurred sixteenth notes ascending and descending (Quarter note = 72)



2. *F Major Etude, Lento e cantabile,* by Kohler, page 10 from SELECTED STUDIES FOR



3. **D Major Etude by Anderson, page 41** from MELODIOUS AND PROGRESSIVE STUDIES BOOK II by R. Cavally (quarter note = 100)



4. **Example Solo** (you may choose to do a different solo): *Sonata in Eb Major* – J.S. Bach – Movement 1 – Beginning to measure 53
