#4 in the materials listed below is an EXAMPLE of the optional solo each student can play. Solos are optional and will be used for consideration for principal positions only. The solo should be a piece of the student's choosing not to exceed 1 minute in length. The chosen piece should be relatively difficult for the student but should demonstrate the student's musical strengths. Pieces from each instrument's solo repertoire are recommended. Remember, the piece given here is an *example* only. It *may* be used, but a piece of the student's choosing is highly recommended.

1. Chromatic Scale – Full range of the instrument *based on student's consistent, comfortable range*. Recommended: written A3 to written A5. Optional: written F#3 to written C6. (quarter note = 120)



2. *In Mia Man Alfin Tu Sei*, measures 1 through 21, by V. Bellini, #136 from "The Art of Phrasing" in COMPLETE CONSERVATORY METHOD FOR CORNET AND TRUMPET by J. B. Arban (quarter note = 70-76)



3. *Allegro*, **#1**, measures **1** through the first eighth note of measure **17** from TRENTE-SIX ETUDES TRANSCENDANTES by T. Charlier (dotted quarter note = 96-120)



4. **Example Solo** (you may choose to do a different solo): *Andante et Scherzo* – J.E. Barat – Beginning of the *Scherzo* to *un peu plus vite*
